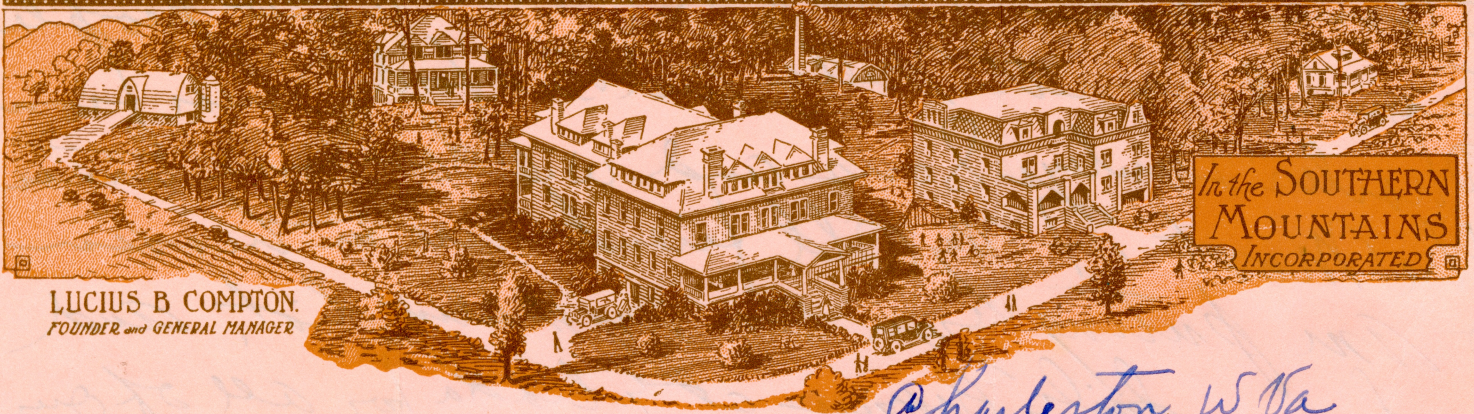

Near 3000 girls have passed through the Home. We have reared near 600 children in Eliada - Have 74 now - And we have no endowment no legacies to draw on Only the Bank of Heaven that is all we need - God has proven himself faithful to prayer - I still have the Group Meeting this year it is from Aug 3 to 16 I am enclosing one of my little papers we have published it Every Month for 38 years we have several thousand readers all over the world before

This war - well My Brother I am expecting Our Lord
to Come Soon - I still hear from a few people
around Smith Mills, and Bedford. I hear from
Charles Donley's Sons and Widow some times
the Most of My Old friends are in heaven
I am putting you on my Mailing list, and
we have daily Prayers at Glinda for all of our
Mailing list -

Write me again and let us keep
in touch with each other until Jesus takes us
I am here for a 2 week revival in this place
and God is blessing some are finding Jesus
as they Saviour - Praise The Lord -
