**Introduction**

The A. B. C. F. M. (American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions), established in 1810, is a company incorporated under the laws of the state of Massachusetts “for the purpose of propagating the Gospel in “heathen” lands by supporting missionaries and diffusing a knowledge of the Holy Scriptures.” It is self-perpetuating and has no ecclesiastical character or relations; however, the Board has practically represented Congregationalists alone.

Coordinate with the growth of the Board itself has been that of its great auxiliaries, the three Woman’s Boards: the Woman’s Board of Foreign Missions (1868), the Woman’s Board of Missions of the Interior (1868), and the Woman’s Board of Missions of the Pacific (1873).

The early growth of the missions was rapid with new fields ever opening before the Board, one of them being the Japan mission. Upon request by Dr. Neesima, “a Japanese,” the Board decided to send D. C. Greene and his wife as the first missionaries to Tokio in 1869. In March, 1870, the mission was moved to Kobe where churches, schools, hospitals, and dispensaries were opened and evangelistic tours begun. The Kioto Training School, now called Doshisha, was opened in 1876, and a school for girls, now Kobe College, was opened. In 1890 the northern Japan Mission at Niigata and Sendai was incorporated as a station of the Japan Mission. In 1891 an impetus was given to the work of the Union Evangelistic Movement, when work was carried on in 42 provinces by 22 denominations.

In 1961 the A. B. C. F. M. joined with the Board of International Missions, the Commission on World Service, and the Congregational Christian Service Committee.

The Japan Mission collection includes the July annual meeting minutes of the Japan Mission of the A. B. C. F. M., from 1888-1912, with the exception of 1897 and 1902. Also included are three docket, four annual reports of the treasurer of the Japan Mission, several items concerning Kobe College (including three calendars), and two photos; a panoramic view of Kobe and the Kobe Church. There is also a letter from Japan's Minister of Justice concerning Mr. Muramatsu and four duplicate pamphlets describing his home for discharged prisoners. Finally, there is a news clipping, constitution of the Japan Cooperative Society, Ltd., committee and interim notes, a booklet of the Bible Union Church Dedication Service, a booklet describing the various Christian schools in Kobe, and other items of interest.

The collection is in good condition and is a complete unit of 50 folders and four envelopes.
