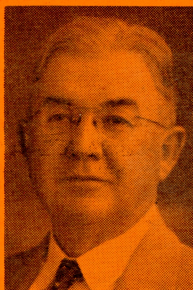

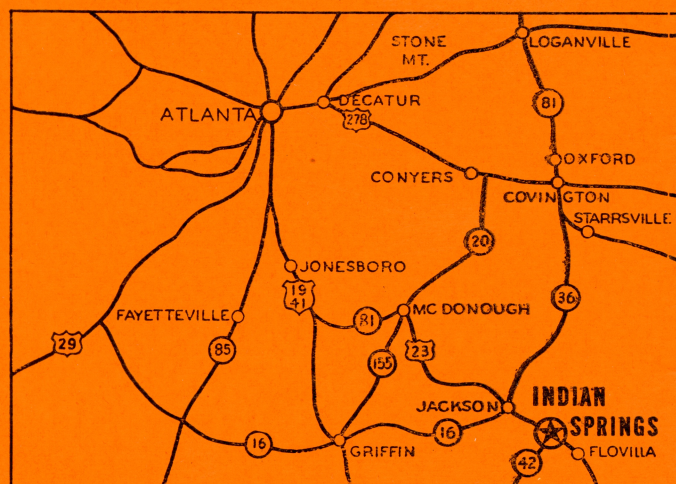

## How to Reach . . . INDIAN SPRINGS



**BY BUS** — The bus stops at the gates. Just say, "Indian Springs Holiness Camp Ground." The Greyhound Limited from the South may stop at the Springs, one mile from the Camp Ground. Check this when purchasing your ticket.

**BY CAR** — See map at left. The Camp Ground is 1 mile from Flovilla, between Atlanta and Macon, 5 miles from Jackson, on Route 42, less than 50 miles from Macon, and approximately 60 miles from Atlanta. Good paved roads from all directions lead to the grounds.
