Dear Mr McKibbon: Got your de osit slips today, this brings the Cash income for the camp (everything included) to \$5840.00, have paid the workers, the espenses of the camp as far as I know, paid Mr Luce \$500 on the Note. Ecnlose your insurance bill that is past due. And have paid the well man \$1200 balance due on the pump and well. Now have in the bank \$1241.22. That should last until Xmas and I will send out notices then in December as some want to get income tax out of the way, and will make payments.

The unpaid pledges now are \$5049.00, allowing about \$1000 that wont come in we will have you might say \$4000 in pledges and the bank account \$1200.00. Should take about \$2000 to \$3000 to get to next camp for actual operating. Unless somebody goes wild on some project. So might be we can pay Mr Luce some more before next camp.

I have written my Boy to see if the Young Folks paid anything on the Note. Also we will have some Book store money but that wont be as much as last year. If we get in a tight we can borow some money on the bonds.

It just gets down to this, we must raise more money or quit spending. This can be thrashed out in the mid year meeting. I will g t up a report for that meeting.

Next Camp should take care of itself if we can make it until then.
