Introduction

The Strother Family Papers contain 0.4 cubic feet of materials which include correspondence, financial documents, legal documents, literary productions, and printed material.

All materials are unrestricted.

Biographical Sketch

The Strother family moved into Kentucky from Virginia near the end of the 18th Century. The early part of the collection centers on Jeremiah Strother, a Methodist minister who founded the Shiloh Methodist Church in Oldham County and a member of the Kentucky General Assembly. He died in 1868. His son, Jeremiah Pierce Strother, was also a Methodist minister at both Highland Park and Richmond first in the first two decades of the 1900s. Finally the collection moves to James Strother, who attempts to develop a family history.
