Introduction

The Ward Family Colelction (1819-1972) contains material from five members of the Ernest F. Ward family: Ernest F., Phebe E., Ethel E., Bessie H., and M. Louise. The collection contains primarily personal material--correspondence, diaries and other literary productions, scrapbook materials, printed materials, legal and financial documents, and photographic material. Within these materials their their work as missionaries, as well as thi work's impact upon themseles and others, is evident.

A large section of the collection is composed of correspondence. This correspondence is very interesting because of the insight it gives into the family itself. Quite freguently from 1893 to 1960's the family was seperated because of the girl's education, done primaril in boarding schools, or because of work responsibilites which left them in different parts of India or the world. Consequently their primary means of communication was correspondence.

The colelction is the result of the merger of two collections. The first collections is the E. F. Ward collection (88-M-001) held by the Special Collections Department, B. L. Fisher Library, Asbury Theological Seminary. The second colelction is the Ward Family Colelction held by the Historical Center of the Free Methodist Church. The collection was arranged anad microfilmed at Asbury THEological Seminary. The findig aid was preparerd by Linda E. Deeks in April 1989.

Biographical Sketch

The Ernest F. Ward family is composed of five members: Ernest Fremont Ward (1853-1938), Phebe Eliabeth Cox Ward (1850-1910), Ethel Ellen Ward (1883-1971), Bessie Helen Ward (1890-), Mary Louise Ward Vore (1893-1921). Since the collection contains material from each, this sketch include information on each individual.

Ernest Fremont Ward was born April 25, 1853 to Pindar and Emily Ward. Phebe Elizabeth Cox, daughter of Carman and Sarah Cox, was born October 7, 1850. Ernest and Phebe first met at a campmeeting in St. Charles, IL. While at this campmeeting Phebe was particularly attracted to a young man with a "heavenly smile." During the meeting Ernest questioned Phebe about missions. She expressed an interest, but admitted knowing very little about foreign missions. He then gave her some tracts and leaflets about the work in India.

She returned home determined to provide some financial support for the young man with the "heavenly smile" who was planning on working in India. To raise these funds she planted an onion patch which she carefully tended throughout the summer. After the harvest she was able to send one hundred dollars for his support.

Ernest and Phebe meet again at the Silver Lake Campmeeting. During one of the services Phebe received God's call to India. Following the service the young couple talked about their futures and their relations to each other. Their plans were confirmed when Ernest received a letter from Albert Norton stating that he believed it God's will that Ernest go to India and to take Phebe as a life companion.

On October 11, 1880 Ernest and Phebe were married. The days following the wedding were spent preparing for their journey to India. Since the Missions Board of the Free Methodist Church had not been organized yet, they departed from Illinois November 16, 1880 as Faith Missionaries to India. They set sail from New York City on the Steamship Anchoria and arrived in Bombay in January.

Upon reaching Ellichpur, they immediately set themselves to task of learning the language. After some time they moved to Burhanpur. While there, on February 22, 1883, Ethel Ellwn was born. In 1885, also during their stay in Burhanpur, Louisa Ranf arrived to help in the missionary effort. Lousia Ranf truly endeared herself to the Wards. With a joyful spirit she was always willing to help wherever she could.

Their next move took them back to Ellichpar. During their stay here Bessie Helen, their second daughter, was born. She arrived on July 9, 1890 and was named for Bessie Helen Ward, Ernest's sister, who died in 1889. A tragedy which occurred in 1892 was the death of Louisa Ranf. She was severely burned in a Church of England service when a kerosene lantern fell on her. She suffered greatly and died five and a half hours later.

In 1892, shortly after Miss Ranf's death, it became possible for the Wards to return to America. It had been twelve years since Ernest and Phebe had left America. Neither Ethel nor Bessie had ever seen America or their relatives who lived there. Their time in America was divided between visiting relative and raising funds for the work in India. While in California visiting the Ward relatives, their third daughter Mary Louise Ward arrived. July 10, 1893 marked her birth. She was named for Mary Louisa Ranf who had been so dearly loved and so tragically lost.

As the time drew near for their return to India, Ernest and Phebe were faced with an agonizing decision concerning their daughters' education. They decided to leave Ethel and Bessie in America to be educated. They set sail in November 1893 with six month old Louisa and with heavy hearts for the two "birdlings" they left behind.

Upon their return to India, they went to work in Raj Nangaon. Much was accomplished here especially during the great famine that struck India. During this time they cared for nearly seven hundred hungry children. Following the famine they were able to construct a bungalow, an orphanage and a school. However, the stresses of the work drained them so that they needed to return to America to rest. The excitement of returning to America and seeing Ethel and Bessie again was dimmed by the need to leave Loise in India. In 1899, after a year in America, the entire Ward family was reunited in India.

While there was much joy because of the reunion, the problem of the girls' education remained. After much prayer an answer was received. Uncle Frank Cox, Phebe's brother, wrote offering to send the girls to school in either in America or India. After much thought and prayer the decision was made to send the girls to Taylor High School for Girls in Poona, India.

While the girls were at Poona, Ernest and Phebe moved to Wun in the Yeomtal District. This was an exciting move for them because they didn't have to build a bungalow, one was waiting for them. This was the first time a home was not to be shared with other missionaries.

One tragedy that did strike was the failure of the bank of Bombay. This bank held the funds that the Wards had received for the girls' education. With all the money gone the girls had to leave school. Once again the question of the girls' education became paramount.

Soon a series of events developed that provided a way for Ethel to return to America to attend Seattle Seminary in Seattle, Washington. She left India on July 8, 1905. Eventually funds became available for Bessie and Louise to return to Taylor High School for Girls in Poona. Two years after Ethel's departure, March 5, 1907, Bessie and Louise also departed for Seattle Seminary.

Ernest and Phebe's next move was to Darwha in the Yeomtal District. Here they built the fifth bungalow they had built since going to India. After several years, they were able to return to America to attend Ethel's graduation from Seattle Seminary. In the spring of 1910 the family was once again reunited.

The Wards had just settled into a home in Seattle when tragedy struck again. On September 1, 1910 Phebe Elizabeth Cox Ward died leaving a grief stricken family behind. Bessie and Louise continued at Seattle Seminary, as Ernest and Ethel prepared to return to India. Ernest and Ethel departed for India in the fall of 1911. Bessie and Louise graduated from Seattle Seminary in the spring of 1913.

At this point the family members moved more independently. Ernest remarried on January 17, 1914 in India. His second wife was Elizabeth Ireland Tucker Ward. "Mother Tucker" died on September 3, 1915. Ernest continued his work in India until his retirement in 1927 when he returned to America. He died in 1938.

Ethel continued her missionary service to the women and children of India. She returned to America to attend Greenville College graduating with the class of 1920. Her retirement in 1960, followed forty-nine years in active missionary service. Before retirement to California her entire life was spent in India except for her education and furloughs. Ethel died on April 21, 1971.

Information about Bessie following her graduation from Seattle Seminary is very limited. She took some nurse's training and did home nursing. She was also a member of the class of 1924 at Greenville College. She lived in California with Ethel after Ethel's retirement.

Louise also graduated from Seattle Seminary in 1913. After teaching school for a few years, she attended Greenville College (dates unknown). On June 16, 1920, in Ann Arbor, MI, Louise became the bride of Hugh Allen Vore. They were preparing for missionary service in India; however, Louise died on August 23, 1921 before they could fulfill this dream.

(General Description)

The Ward Family Collection contains material from the five members of the Ernest F. Ward family. Where the author or originator of the material could be determined, the material has been placed in that person section. If the author or the originator could not be determined, the material was placed in the section called "Ward Family Collection." The six sections in the collection are: Bessie H. Ward, Ernest F. Ward, Ethel E. Ward, M. Louise Ward, Phebe E. Ward, and Ward Family Collection.

Under each section the series follow the normal arrangement: biographical, proceedings, correspondence, subject files, reports, literary productions, legal documents, financial documents, scrapbook materials, maps, lists, printed material and photographic material. Correspondence written by family member to family members has been arranged by author/originator. Correspondence received from persons outside the family was placed in section for the family member receiving the letter.

The 6.5 cubic feet collection spans the years 1819-1972; however, the bulk ranges from 1880-1971. A large portions of the collection appear to have been collected by Ernest and Ethel. Overall the collection, especially the correspondence give interesting insight into the family.
