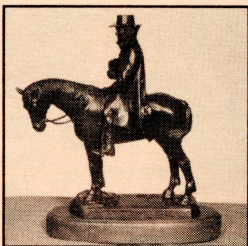

HISTORY AND HERITAGE

Each summer, since 1890, Indian Springs Holiness Camp Ground has held before the world the high claims of God in Jesus Christ, while standing firmly upon the doctrine of "holiness in heart and life." The Camp's four founding fathers were committed to the spread of "Scriptural Holiness" following the Wesleyan Arminian position of Biblical teaching. Also, they believed the Bible to be the Divinely inspired, infallible word of God. They proclaimed God's redemption plan for everyone through justification by faith, the witness of the Holy Spirit, and entire sanctification of the believer – sanctification being a second definite work of grace in the human heart subsequent to regeneration.

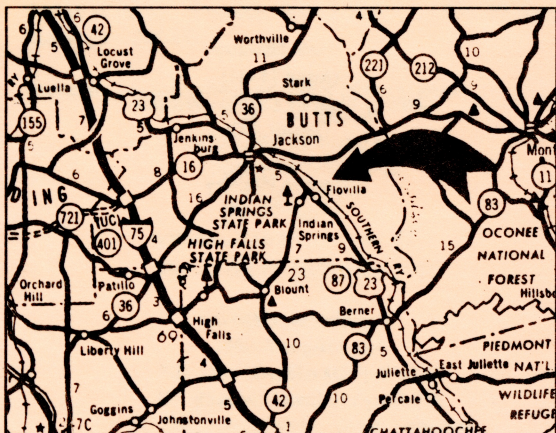
