## MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING Indian Springs Holiness Camp Ground Monday, May 9, 1983

Members Present: Frank Harris, Luce, Edenfield, H. Davis, Aycock, Zweifel, Smart, Lindsey, Johnson, B. Lee, P. Barrett, M. Barrett, Andrews, Crouse, T. Davis, Fuller, Fred Harris, McKenzie, Middlebrooks, Newby, R. Smith, Batchelor

President Harris presided. Meeting opened with prayer by Fuller.

P. Barrett moved approval of minutes of last meeting without reading. Seconded. Passed.

Luce made Buildings & Grounds Committee report: New sewer lines installed in the 5 problem areas of sewerage system. Problems of sewers solved for now. Boys and girls dormitories improved. Cost of both projects \$15.948.21. Benson Memorial is now girls dormitory. Will hold 48 girls. Old boys dormitory now girls dormitory. Old girls dormitory now boys dormitory. 80 girls can be accommodated on camp ground now and 60 boys. Will need additional counselors for young people. 6 street lights to be added to camp ground. Lights will be connected to cottages nearby and these cottages will pay for current during camp meeting. Current cut off reat of the year. New mattresses and pillows put in girls dormitory. Microphones to be put on the floor of main tabernacle to be used during peoples meeting. Buildings & Grounds Committee recommends that Al Smart be named chairman of committee. Committee also recommends that Al Smart stay on grounds for 6 months and pay him same salary as Ken Roussell wasbbeing paid. Smart to work with Barney during these 6 months. P. Barrett moved approval of committee's recommendations concerning Smart. Seconded. Passed. Luce announced that two students from Asbury College have been hired for 2 months this summer to help prepare grounds for camp meeting.

Luce announced that Ken Roussell has resigned as assistant caretaker and has moved to Nashville, Tennessee. Board members should be on the lookout for a younger man to take his place. Time is coming soon when Barney Ferguson will probably resign due to age.

H. Davis gave Treasurer's report: Balance on hand Oct. 1, 1982-\$11,805.94. Total cash received to April 30, 1983-\$53,288.96. Disbursements-\$55,640.31. Balance April 30, 1983-\$9,454.59. Pledges coming in better than ever before.

Luce made Pulpit Committee report: Col. Andy Miller to be evangelist in 1984 in place of Reuben Welch.

Crouse said hotel reservations coming in at a fast rate for camp meeting.

Batchelor said that insurance on contents of cafeteria has been increased.

Johnson said that OMS is in charge of missionary service this year.

Edenfield moved that space in mall of Memorial Building be limited to 6 organizations: OMS, WGM, Asbury College, Asbury Seminary, Wesley Seminary, and Bethany Homes in Kentucky. Motion seconded. Passed.

Meeting adjourned with prayer by Lindsey.
