My dear Brother McKibben:

I trust this letter finds you well. It seems a long time since I saw you and had fellowship with you.

My reason for writing is to make an inquiry about my engagement for Indian Springs this coming summer. I seem to be the "problem boy" among your workers. No one regrets it more than I.

My request is to be released from the last Sunday of the Camp to fly back to my pulpit here.

The reasons are as follows: I have been asked to devote some time to assisting Billy Graham in the New York Crusade this summer. Besides, I am due to leave for Korea and Formosa the first week in September. This puts me in a squeeze with regard to my work here.

Would you be good enough to ask your committee if, in these circumstances, they would release me for this Sunday?

It is with much reluctance that I send you this letter because I know how difficult it is for the officials of the Camp when the program is disrupted.

I might suggest, as an alternative, my being released the first Sunday instead of the last. Would this make it any easier for you?
