## Frank C. Laubach Teaching Materials and Publications ARC1982-001

Frank Charles Laubach (1884-1970) was born September 2 in Benton, Pennsylvania where he developed his initial missionary interest from devout parents.

Frank was graduated from Princeton in 1909, attended Union Theological Seminary from 1911 to 1914 and received his Ph.D. from Columbia University in 1915. On May 15, 1912, he married Effa Seely, a nurse and teacher. One son, Robert S., was born to this union. Together they became educational missionaries of the Congregational Church to the Philippines in 1915.

Dr. Laubach served as Dean of Union College in Manila from 1922-26. Also during this period he developed his picture literacy word charts and began his literacy program. In 1930 these were incorporated into his world wide literacy program known as "Each One Teach One." For the remainder of his life he traveled around the world on literacy tours and co-authored more than 200 primers for illiterate adults in over 165 languages in 51 countries. Dr. Laubach also authored more than 50 books and pamphlets on a variety of subjects before his death on June 11, 1970.

The Frank C. Laubach collection consists of several published works of an inspirational nature and thirteen teacher's manuals and student books used in his literacy program. Also, included is one biographical piece.

The collection is in very good condition. The contents have come to the B. L. Fisher Library from various sources and no attempt was made to keep original order. They have been arranged in three series to be most usable.
