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They sang a sweet hymn about the  
merriness of the Believers with Christ  
and one verse between each baptism  
as they were coming up out of pure  
the typical burial - a young lady of  
the Presbyterian church was first  
oh! it was so solemn - and the prayer  
so sweet that they might accept  
the humiliation and inconvenience

morning that a lady who had urged  
her very much to be baptised this  
summer - an Episcopalian lady she
