Brooklyn May 24 1844

My precious Hannah

Yours is just received and it did me so much good. The dear Lord is going to bring thee into a large place. I know it. Oh wont it

be lovely if I am permitted to be with you once more.

My housekeeper has not been down stairs yet. and I have been afraid that I should have to give up going altogether. But she says that she thinks I can ^{go} well enough next week. I would like to come on Saturday if possible. but dont see how I can.

I am getting myself ready. as

fast as possible and hope to be
with you on Monday night. but
if the dear God thinks otherwise
we will say wot we? The will
of the God be done. I have
been to Him in earnest prayer
leaving it all in His hands.
Oh it will be so sweet if we
can have the privilege of
abandoning ourselves to the Lord
once more together.

The dear God is nearer to me
than ever darling. He is
so precious to my soul and I
am more of a babe than ever.
O how I do praise Him that
He has brought me to this.
While I live will I praise Him
I am obliged to give you a
short letter this time. Wont we
talk when we get face to face?
